FIFTEENTH CANADIAN CONGRESS OF APPLIED MECHANICS— CANCAM '95

28 May–2 June 1995

The 15th Canadian Congress of Applied Mechanics will be held from 28 May to 2 June 1995 at the University of Victoria in Victoria, British Columbia.

These congresses, which take place once every two years, are intended :

to provide an international forum for communicating recent and projected advances in all fields of applied mechanics ;

to assemble and provide an opportunity for direct information exchange among delegates from industry, research laboratories, and academic institutions.
