ELEVENTH WORLD CONFERENCE ON EARTHQUAKE ENGINEERING

23–28 June 1996

Acapulco, Mexico

The Mexican Society on Earthquake Engineering is pleased to announce the Eleventh World Conference on Earthquake Engineering. The event will take place in Acapulco, Mexico from 23–28 June 1996.

The Eleventh World Conference on Earthquake Engineering will provide a unique opportunity for both researchers and practitioners from around the world to share the latest knowledge and techniques for understanding and mitigating the effects of earthquakes. It is the aim of the Conference to bring together, and enhance dialogue among, worldwide professionals from the broad range of disciplines committed to reducing the impact of earthquakes on the built and natural environment.

The technical sessions of the Conference will cover the following topics :

1. engineering seismology ;
2. experiences derived from recent earthquakes ;
3. laboratory and field tests ;
4. response analysis : algorithms and results ;
5. active and passive control of structural response ;
6. special structures and systems ;
7. extended systems ;
8. structural design criteria and methods ;
9. seismic evaluation and rehabilitation of structures.

In addition to formal technical sessions for discussion of accepted papers, a wide variety of technical activities will be programmed : invited lectures, state-of-the-art reports, poster sessions, workshops on specific topics, meetings of technical committees, technical exhibitions. The final format of the Conference will be announced later.

The official language of the Conference will be English.
