POLYMODEL 14 MATHEMATICAL MODELLING IN THE 90's CURRENT INDUSTRIAL PROBLEMS CALL FOR CONTRIBUTIONS AND PARTICIPANTS 21–22 May 1991

The Conference is being organized jointly by ICI Chemicals and Polymers and Teesside Polytechnic. The aim is to identify current industrial problems in the area of Mathematical Modelling and to provide an opportunity for collaboration between industrialists and academics in the field.

Contributions of current industrial problems are invited. These should be unsolved or partially solved. Additionally, contributions to a poster/software display are invited. These should be examples of successful case studies in Mathematical Modelling or novel solution techniques/software.

Intending contributors are requested to send a description of their contributions to the conference secretary as soon as possible.

Contributions have already been received from the following companies, NEI/Rolls Royce, ICI, British Gas, British Steel and British Maritime Technology Cortec. The Conference will be made up of short presentations followed by parallel workshop sessions which will enable discussion of problem formulation and solution. The intention is to provide an occasion for industrial/academic links to be formed with a view to future collaborative ventures in Mathematical Modelling.

The conference fee is £120 which includes attendance at all sessions, lunches, refreshments and the conference dinner. Accommodation is available at the cost of £25 per day for bed and breakfast on the nights of 20 and 21 May 1991.
