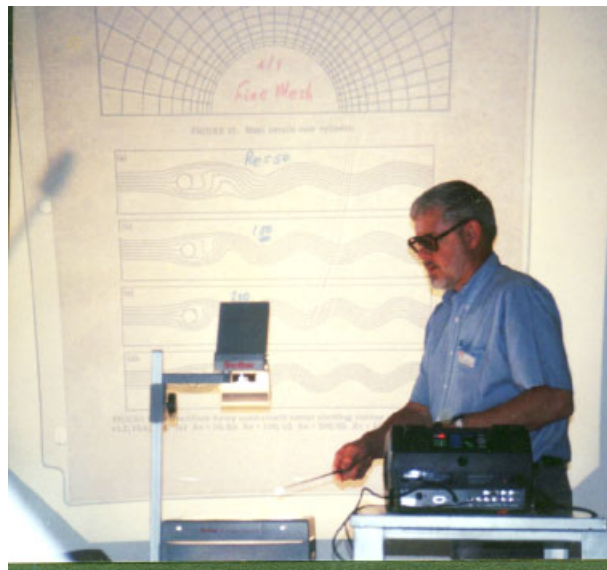
Founding Editor Dr Philip M. Gresho

When the *International Journal for Numerical Methods in Fluids* was established in 1980, Prof. Cedric Taylor, the Founding Editor, invited Dr Philip M. Gresho to join him as the Co-Editor. Since that time, Phil Gresho has worked tirelessly to ensure that the *Journal* gained, and then maintained, a reputation for publishing papers of the highest quality. In 1981 the first volume was published as a quarterly journal, the frequency increased to bi-monthly in 1983, then to monthly in 1984, and growing further steadily year by year to 24 issues in 1992 and most recently to 36 issues per year.

In addition to his editorial work, Phil Gresho has made many major technical contributions to the field. His recent text ‘Incompressible Flow and the Finite Element Method’ with Dr R. L. Sani was received with much positive acclaim and clearly demonstrates Phil’s extensive knowledge and insights into numerical methods in fluids.

Phil Gresho retired as Editor of the *International Journal for Numerical Methods in Fluids* at the end of 2002. His wide knowledge, experience and sharp wit will be missed by his colleagues. The Editors and the Publisher wish Phil a happy and healthy retirement.
