FOURTH INTERNATIONAL HEAT TRANSFER CONFERENCE 1970

The Fourth International Heat Transfer Conference will be held from August 31 to September 5, 1970 in Paris/Versailles. It will be organized by a French-German Committee established by the Société Française des Thermiciens (Paris), Société de Chimie Industrielle (Paris), Verfahrenstechnische Gesellschaft im VDI (Düsseldorf) and DECHEMA (Frankfurt/M.). The General Assembly for Heat Transfer Conferences is sponsoring this Conference.

More than 700 papers have been offered. About half of them have been selected by an international committee with members from seven nations (Canada, Federal Republic of Germany, France, Japan, United Kingdom, USA, USSR). Most likely the following subjects will be treated:

- Thermal radiation
- Conduction
- Forced convection
- Natural convection
- Boiling and condensation
- Combined heat transfer

(also evaporation, granular beds, fluidized beds)

Heat transfer in rheological systems

Heat exchangers

(also vibrations, extended surfaces, etc.)

Measuring techniques.

Simultaneous translation will be provided in English, French and German.
