INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL AND SEMINAR

INTERNATIONAL CENTRE OF HEAT AND MASS TRANSFER

The 1973 International Summer School directed by Professor Perry Blackshear of the University of Minnesota will be held at Trogir, Yugoslavia on 27–31 August, 1973 (tentative). The faculty for the school includes: Forman A. Williams and Richard Corlett of the U.S.A., Frank Steward of Canada, P. H. Thomas of England, and P.G. Seeger of the F.R. Germany. Distinguished lectures will be given by Professor E. R. G. Eckert of the U.S.A. and Professor E. A. Brun of France. The purpose of the Summer School is to introduce scientists and engineers who are interested in Fire Research to the basic principles necessary to understand the topic. The lectures will start from widely understood principles and in a logical fashion move up to the forefront of the topic. Specifically the lectures will encompass processes in burning condensed fuels, flame radiation, and fire convective phenomena. Important interrelationships be-

tween these classes of phenomena will be described. For details contact Professor Blackshear.

The 1973 International Seminar "Heat Transfer from Flames" will be held at Trogir on 3–8 September 1973 (tentative) immediately following the Summer School. This 6th International Seminar will concentrate on three main areas in flame heat transfer: Heat Transfer in Steady Confined Processes, including processes and combustors, Heat Transfer in Unsteady Confined Systems, including internal combustion engines, Heat Transfer from Open Flames, including radiative heat transfer from refinery flares and burning plumes and convective heat transfer from impinging flames. The chairman of the Seminar Committee is Professor John Beer, Department of Chemical Engineering and Fuel Technology, the University of Sheffield, Sheffield S1 3JD, England. Abstracts of papers are due on 10 April 1973.
