### INTERNATIONAL ADVANCED STUDY INSTITUTE ON 'MASS TRANSFER WITH CHEMICAL REACTION IN MULTIPHASE SYSTEMS'

*Purpose:* This institute is primarily a high level teaching activity at which various aspects of 'Mass transfer with chemical reaction in multiphase systems' will be presented by 13 eminent lecturers in a systematic and coherently structured programme. In addition, there will be sessions for discussions and short original presentations (not only from lecturers but also from other interested participants).

Both survey lectures and the original presentations will be published as Proceedings.

*Participants:* Scientists and engineers from all countries are invited to apply for participation. In order to facilitate the exchange of ideas and allow for discussion, the attendance will be limited to about 75 persons and the entire Institute will be held at one hotel. There will be no registration fee and a limited number of stipends to cover accommodation fees will be available to applicants from NATO countries.
