# INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MECHANICS OF TWO-PHASE FLOWS

The conference will concentrate on various aspects of two-phase flows. Fluid mechanics and thermodynamics aspects of particulate two-phase flows are of special interest, especially if they may be of use in deepening the understanding of the physics of two-phase flows. Contributions are invited that utilize modern measuring techniques such as phase-Doppler anemometry, holography etc. to provide local information of two-phase flows. Of interest also are numerical investigations carried out by suitable finite difference and/or finite element techniques providing solutions to the basic equations of two-phase flows.
