This issue contains papers of lectures and talks presented at Quantum Structures '96, Berlin, from July 28 to August 3, the third of a series of conferences proposed to be held biannually by the International Quantum Structures Association. We thank the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft and the President of the Technical University of Berlin for their essential financial support. The next meeting will take place in 1998 at Mikulas-Jan, Slovakia. We thank the editor-in-chief of this journal as well as Plenum Press for the preparation of this issue.

Besides the classical fields interest to the Association, we also wished to attract the attention of the participants to other topics that have deep relations to fundamental aspects of quantum theory, namely quantum theory on curved space-time and quantum optics, communication, and computation.
