Pacific Coast Entomologists to Celebrate Centennial in June

The meeting of the Pacific branch of the Entomological Society of America next June is being planned to highlight the theme of entomology's centennial in America. The meeting is scheduled for June 22 to 24 at the Pilot Butte Inn in Bend, Ore.

A series of invitational talks is being planned on the following subjects: specificity of acaricides, reorganization of the Bureau of Entomology and Plant Quarantine, 100 years of insect control by chemicals, food habits in *Lepidoptera*, developments in taxonomy during the past 100 years, entomology in Iran, and some historical aspects of Pacific Coast entomology.

Panel discussions are scheduled on soil insecticides, integration of laboratory and field research, and entomology in the "roaring twenties." One session is to be devoted to the general field of insect ecology, insect biology, and the general aspects of systematics. Movies will also be shown, including commercial films wherein advertising is limited to 5% or less of showing time.

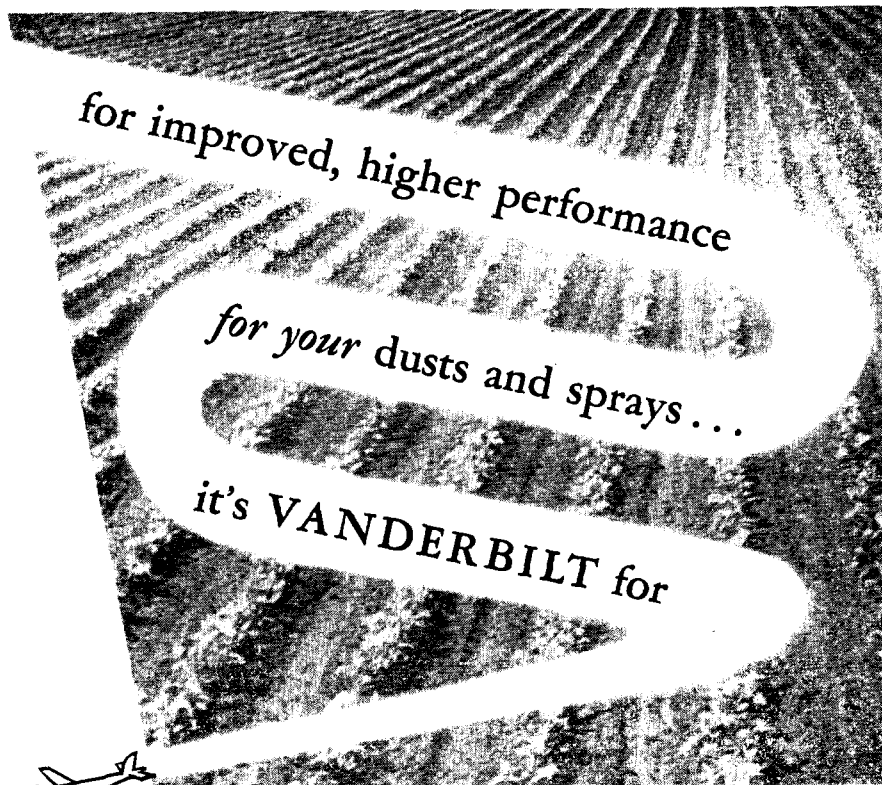
