Conference on 'Electrodes in Industrial Applications'

A conference to discuss aspects of the use of electrodes in industrial applications has been organized by industrial members of the Executive Committee of the Society and will be held at Shell Thornton Research Centre, Chester, 6–7 March, 1974.
