

ANNOUNCEMENT

As of September 1, 1973, the Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn will become the Polytechnic Institute of New York, it has been announced by PIB Acting President Norman P. Auburn.

This name change reflects a merger between Polytechnic and New York University's School of Engineering and Science, he pointed out.

Authorized by the New York State Legislature, the merger creates a new institution based in downtown Brooklyn, Farmingdale on Long Island, Washington Square in Manhattan, and the Bronx.

The new name for the merged institution was required by the merger terms and approved by Polytechnic's Corporation (trustees).
