# PLASMINOGEN ACTIVATION IN FIBRINOLYSIS IN TISSUE REMODELLING AND DEVELOPMENT

October 22–25, 1991

The purpose of the meeting is to present recent observations in fibrinolysis in a broad concept of health and disease. Much attention has focused on thrombolytic therapy, but plasminogen activation also plays a role in proteolysis in tissue remodelling. Both processes are strictly regulated to act locally, but involve different regulatory mechanisms and substrates. The extent to which they influence each other physiologically will be considered, particularly in terms of the pathology of inflammation and tissue repair. Possible intervention and prevention strategies will be considered.
