BOOK REVIEW

Gas Chromatography, by E. BAYER, an Elsevier Monograph, Elsevier Publishing Co., Amsterdam, 1961, xii + 240 pages, price Dfl. 13.00, 26 s.

The original German edition of this book, which was reviewed some time ago in this journal (Vol. 3 (1960) 380) has now been revised and translated into English. Although there are already numerous books on gas chromatography in the English language it will be welcome as an introduction to the topic. An appendix lists a large number of retention volumes (30 tables) and there is a reference list (420 references) and a subject index. The price has been reduced to about one third of the price of the German edition.
