Editorial

This year the Bibliography Section will be published in two volumes (No. 783 and No. 784). The rules of classification of individual entries will not differ from those used in the past year. The indexes for this year will be attached to the second volume of this year (No. 784). We have, however, introduced two differences compared to the previous Bibliography Section volumes. The first is that owing to the vastly expanding number of papers on capillary electromigration techniques we limit the entries in the 4e subsection of the Electrophoresis part to contributions dealing with methodological advances and theoretical problems of this category of separations. Applications of capillary electromigration techniques are to be looked for under the appropriate category of compounds. A similar situation has developed in all sections of this Bibliography, i.e. Liquid Column Chromatography, Gas Chromatography, Planar Chromatography and Electrophoresis with the subsection 34b regarding food analysis. This led us to introduce the second change, i.e. the respective analyzed compounds are to be looked for under the appropriate subsections dealing with a particular type of chemical entities. Simple applications are not cross-referenced which means that e.g. vitamin A related compounds in carrots have to be looked for under subsection 27, not under 34b (no cross-referencing will be supplied).
