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Table 1, line 1, last column, the electrophoretic mobility (μ_{ep}) of SQ·H₂O should be $-21.60\cdot 10^{-5}$ cm² V⁻¹ s⁻¹. Also in Table 1, the relative mobilities calculated from Z/r^2 for SIOX and SMI should be inverted. It has been pointed out [1] that the equations given (p. 175, right side) for the correlations between μ_{ep} and (Z/r and $Z/r^2)$ are not consistent with the data in Table 1 and thus the plots (solid lines, Figs. 1 and 2) are also in error. The corrected eqs. and correlation coefficients (R) in the 174 mM sodium phosphate buffer are:

$$\mu_{ep}/10^{-5} = -11.22 + 52.22 \, Z/r$$
: $R = 0.752$

$$\mu_{\rm ep}/10^{-5} = -5.244 + 265.9 \, Z/r^2$$
: $R = 0.912$

And in the case of the Z/r^3 regression (p. 177, right side, top paragraph):

$$\mu_{ep}/10^{-5} = -4.413 + 1008 \, Z/r^3$$
: $R = 0.974$

Again, the regression plots and correlation coefficients at the other three buffer concentrations have the same relativities.
