Editorial

In the current year we are going to keep the classification scheme and subsectioning of the Bibliography Section in the same way as in year 1999 (for details see Editorial in Journal of Chromatography A, Vol. 860). There will be, however, three minor alterations introduced this year namely: (i) the references quoted by CA number only (without the author's names and title) will be deleted as the response of the users of our Bibliography says that these references (which contribute only a little to the advancement of separation science and refer exclusively to applications or to papers which are difficult to find anyway) are hardly looked for by the users;

(ii) the other change occurs in subsection 32i the heading of which will sound Plant extracts and traditional Chinese medicines. The last change (iii) refers to concomitant use of CA Select Plus in addition to the conventional CA references. These references will be indicated as CA Select Plus where applicable.

Let us remind that the papers dealing with electrochromatography should be (as in the year 1999) looked for in a separate subsection of Capillary Electrophoresis.
