

## INTRODUCTION

Presenting the Subject Index for all the four different parts of the Bibliography Section as well as presenting the Index of Types of Compounds Chromatographed has become a tradition in the Journal. The following indexes refer to both volumes of Bibliography published this year (940 and 941). Because the methodological part differs substantially in different techniques, we have retained the subdivision system applied throughout the Bibliography applying the following abbreviations: L = Liquid column chromatography, G = Gas chromatography, P = Planar chromatography, E = Gel electrophoresis, C = Capillary electrophoresis, electrokinetic chromatography and electrochromatography. As indicated, gel electrophoresis (E) and capillary electromigration techniques (C) constitute separate sections. The reason for this has been described in the Introduction published in No 1 Vol. 860. Entries relevant to supercritical fluid chromatography are to be looked for in the section on Gas chromatography. Micellar electrokinetic chromatography, microemulsion electrokinetic chromatography and electrochromatography are to be looked for in the section on Capillary electrophoresis and electrokinetic chromatography. In entries that are heavily populated by chromatographic papers we made a further subdivision into Techniques and Applications. In the Subject Index a selection was made in such entries and an appropriate note was attached. Commonly used sorbents and procedures were not included into the Index. Reviews are clearly indicated.
