Digital Camera

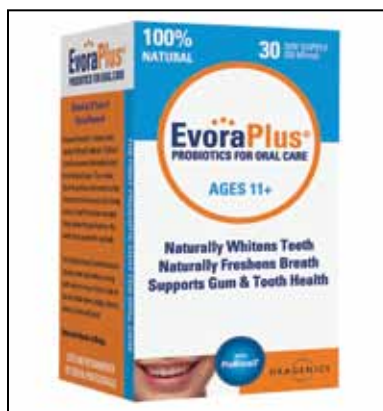

Probiotic Mints

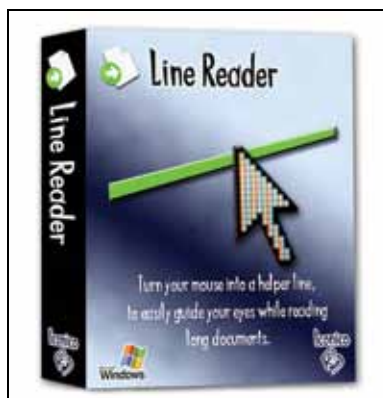

Screen-Reading Tool

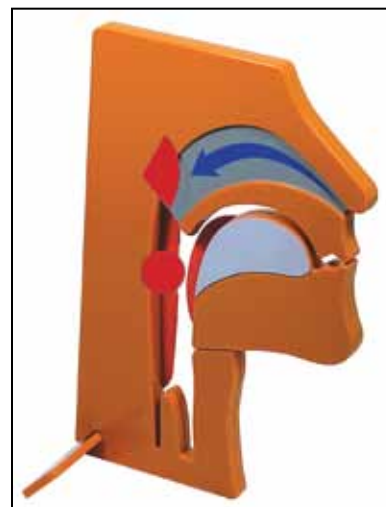
