Fifth International Conference on Numerical Methods in Fluid Dynamics

Twenty University of Technology, Enschede, The Netherlands, June 28–July 2, 1976.

The subject of the conference is the numerical solution of fluid-dynamical problems in such areas as Meteorology, Oceanography, Geophysics, Aero- and hydrodynamics, Magneto hydrodynamics, and Biomechanics. All aspects of fluid dynamics will be included but special interest will be attached to the improvement of computational methods and the development of new methods.

There will be presented eight general lectures by invited speakers. About 50 contributed research papers of 20 minutes each (15 minutes for presentation and 5 for discussion) can be accepted. An international Papers Committee will be responsible for the selection of contributed papers on the basis of abstracts submitted by the authors.

The Conference Proceedings will contain the complete texts of all talks and will be published subsequently by Springer Verlag as a volume of lecture notes in physics.
