It is also finding applications in applied subjects such as systems control, econometrics, and quantum physics.

The journal *K*-Theory will provide a forum for the presentation, discussion, and critical evaluation of significant, as well as outstanding, mathematical advances in which *K*-Theory plays a part. It will be open to all mathematical disciplines and it is expected that this will bring together work having close conceptual and methodological relationships which, hitherto, have been scattered in the literature.

K-*Theory* will also publish survey articles describing the role and influence of *K*-Theory in mathematics.
