Emeritus Professor J.C. (Colin) Tatlow (1923–2008)

Professor Colin Tatlow died on 9th April 2008 in hospital after a long period of illness. Among his many contributions to organofluorine chemistry, he was a founding Editor of Journal of Fluorine Chemistry in 1971 and continued active editorial work until 1997. Since this time he has been an Honorary Editor. Colin's 80th birthday was marked by a collection of papers dedicated to him and a short memoir from two of his former students, Drs. Paul Coe and A.K.
