

Publications of T. Dale Stewart (1901–1997)

ABSTRACT: T. D. Stewart (1901–1997) published at least 394 works between the years 1929 and 1992. These include 118 reviews, 40 abstracts, 227 articles or book chapters, five edited volumes, and four books or monographs.

In compiling this list of publications, we began with Stewart's own list that he maintained until 1986. In addition, we conducted a computer search of the literature for publications bearing Stewart's name, searched Smithsonian files housing his offprints, examined his bound volumes of his publications, and searched the *American Journal of Physical Anthropology* and the *Journal of Forensic Sciences* for published abstracts and reviews. This effort located 394 publications, 118 reviews, 40 abstracts, 227 articles or book chapters, five edited volumes, and four books or monographs. Although we made a concerted effort to locate all of his published works, it is certainly possible that others remain undetected, especially reviews and abstracts in journals other than those examined.

Stewart maintained his own publication list until 1986. This list contained approximately 229 entries and generally lacked abstracts and reviews. Our own search through 1986 revealed 391 publications. Thus, in that time period, Stewart published 162 items (mostly reviews and abstracts) that he did not consider sufficiently important to include in his own list.

We have examined all of the actual publications in the following list to verify the accuracy of the references. In this effort I acknowledge the assistance of the Smithsonian Institution Libraries, research assistant Erica Jones, and interns Dawn A. Defenbaugh, Beau Goldstein, and Janell MacDonald of my office.
