The Fayette County, Kentucky, Medical Examiner's Office seeks the assistance of any reader who might be able to help them identify the remains of an African American female found 1 July, 2000, near Winchester Road at its intersection with New Circle Road behind Reno's Restaurant in Lexington, KY.

This individual was approximately mid-20s to early 30s, 5'0" to 5'3" tall with dark curly hair with woven extensions held back

in a pony tail. The upper and lower central incisor teeth show unusual features. Estimated time of death is between spring 1997 and winter 1999. She was wearing light colored jeans and a T-shirt with a Millikin University (Decatur, IL) radio station logo.
