





Preface

This issue contains papers presented at the Conference on Hazardous Waste Remediation held at Montana State University, Bozeman, MT, USA, June 8–10, 1994. The Center for Biofilm Engineering, which is supported in part by a National Science Foundation center award and by many industrial partners, provided leadership in organizing and hosting the conference. Montana State University is a consortium university of the Great Plains–Rocky Mountain Hazardous Substance Research Center, headquartered at Kansas State University, which was a co-sponsor and assisted with organization and planning. The National Institute for Environmental Health Sciences, a co-sponsor, provided travel grants to a number of their investigators to present their research at the conference. Several other co-sponsors assisted with the conference, also.

Papers for this issue were selected from more than 100 presented at the conference.
