To limit the scope the following areas are excluded: work place health & safety, drugs, and nuclear related topics. The Journal is published in two parts:

Part A: Risk Assessment and Management

- Characterization of the harmful effects of hazardous materials
- Impact assessment methods and models – acute and chronic effects of hazardous chemical releases
- Approaches to risk assessment and management, including legislation
- Incident case histories and lessons for risk management

Part B: Environmental Technologies

- Pollution control processes
- Inherently safer and cleaner technologies
- Treatment and disposal of solid, liquid and gaseous hazardous wastes
- Remediation of contaminated soil and groundwater
