

The *Journal of Inclusion Phenomena* reports on original research into all aspects of the study of host-guest systems, in which the host structure may range from a synthetic macromolecule, through heterocyclic systems, to natural or synthetic minerals. The range of guest entities is similarly broad, comprising atomic, molecular, and ionic species. Naturally, the preparation and characterisation of the compounds plays a major role, but articles on the theoretical and thermodynamic aspects of the inclusion state will also be included. In addition, the applications and use of inclusion compounds in, for instance, the pharmaceutical and flavouring industries, in chromatography, and in catalytic and battery systems, are given attention.
