XVIII International Symposium on Macrocyclic Chemistry

Enschede, The Netherlands, June 27 – July 2 1993

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME. The chemistry of macrocycles has initiated the development of molecular recognition as a specific field. Macrocycles play an important role in this field, which now also includes other classes of molecular receptors with a wide variety of structures.

The meeting will focus on the synthesis, properties and applications of macrocycles together with molecular receptors.

The scientific themes will be selected for their fundamental interest as well as for their industrial importance. The programme will consist of:

- Plenary Lectures (50 min and 10 min discussion)
- Young Scientist Symposium that will give a number of young colleagues the opportunity to present their work in Short Talks (20 min and 10 min discussion)
- Poster presentation

In addition the third Izatt–Christensen Award will be presented.
