

## Preface

This special issue of the Journal of Inclusion Phenomena and Macrocyclic Chemistry contains short review articles and full papers selected from some of the invited lectures, as well as oral and poster presentations, at the 11th International Cyclodextrin Symposium, held in Reykjavik, Iceland between May 5th and 8th 2002.

This symposium was the eleventh of a consecutive series held every other year. The first one was organized by Professor Szejtli in Budapest, Hungary (1982), and the second one by Professor Nagai in Tokyo, Japan (1984). The following symposia were held in Lancaster (Dr. Davies, 1986), Munich (Dr. Huber, 1988), Paris (Professor Duchêne, 1990), Chicago (Dr. Hedges, 1992), Tokyo (Professor Nagai, 1994), Budapest (Professor Szejtli, 1996), Santiago de Compostela (Professor Torres Labandeira, 1998), Ann Arbor (Dr. Schmid, 2000) and then in Reykjavik (2002). The aim of these meetings has been to enhance scientific understanding of cyclodextrins, to promote technological advances within the field of cyclodextrins and to encourage cooperation between scientists from the various different disciplines and backgrounds.
