ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The third Oak Ridge Symposium on Radiopharmaceutical Dosimetry is to be held October 7-10, 1980, at the American Museum of Science and Energy, Oak Ridge, Tennessee.
