The course "Advanced Body/Musculoskeletal MR Visiting Fellowship Program for Physicians," sponsored by the University of Pennsylvania Medical Center, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, will be held November 6-10, 2000, at the University of Pennsylvania Medical Center, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Due to the popularity of both the Musculoskeletal and Advanced Body visiting fellowships, we are now offering a week that includes some of the important features of both programs. The musculoskeletal portion (approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ days) will cover mainly the knee, shoulder, and spine regions. As in the week-long musculoskeletal fellowship, a variety of teaching methods are employed including didactic lectures, special independent case reviews and discussions, and small-group discussions of imaging techniques and protocols. The advanced body portion (also $2\frac{1}{2}$ days) will include topical coverage of the upper abdomen, male and female pelvis, breast, and vascular regions.
