We are pleased to announce the incorporation of *Advances in Magnetic Resonance* into the *Journal of Magnetic Resonance*. *Advances in Magnetic Resonance*, edited originally by John Waugh from 1965 through 1990 and subsequently by Warren Warren, is recognized as the premier review series in the field of magnetic resonance. We are fortunate that Warren Warren has agreed to continue as editor of the Advances in Magnetic Resonance reviews. The principal difference is that Academic Press can publish these reviews much more rapidly in the Web and print versions of the *Journal of Magnetic Resonance*. This not only will make the information more timely, but also serves to integrate access to findings in the field of magnetic resonance. One Advances in Magnetic Resonance review will be published in each of the three annual volumes of the *Journal of Magnetic Resonance*.

We strive to reduce the amount of time from submission to publication of all contributions. New methods of handling Communications that should accelerate their publication are being implemented. Articles are published on the Web site as soon as they are completed rather than waiting for individual issues. All authors now receive page proofs in electronic PDF format.

The journal will continue to evolve, and we invite the comments of our contributors, reviewers, and readers. In particular, we welcome recommendations for new review topics in Advances in Magnetic Resonance as well as the submission of Communications for accelerated publication.
