Page 1212. In eq 3, $f(\text{C,H})$ should be preceded by a plus sign rather than a minus sign. The data in the paper was analyzed using the correct version of the equation, and this typographical error has no impact on the results or conclusions. The correct equation is given below

$$\Delta H_f = n_{\text{C-C}}E_{\text{C-C}} + n_{\text{C-H}}E_{\text{C-H}} + n_{\text{C-C-C}}E_{\text{C-C-C}} + n_{\text{C-C-H}}E_{\text{C-C-H}} + n_{\text{H-C-H}}E_{\text{H-C-H}} + f(\text{C,H}) \quad (3)$$

where $f(\text{C,H}) = (170.6 + E_{\text{C}})n_{\text{C}} + 52.1n_{\text{H}}$.

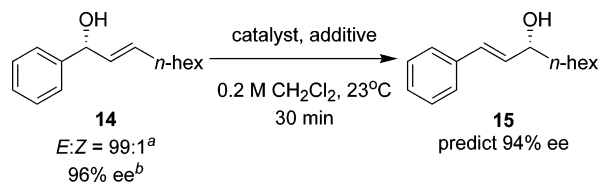
