Microbrush Plus

Microbrush plus applicators are designed to be used for applying solutions to the teeth. The tip is made of small, non-linting, non-absorbent fibres, which hold the solution in suspension to prevent dripping. The plastic handle can be bent to aid access to awkward areas. They are used by many Orthodontists to apply etchant and primer during bonding.




FIG. 1 Regular and new fine size microbrushes.

In addition to the popular standard size a new fine size is now available (Fig. 1).

The manufacturers have recently launched a special dispenser (Fig. 2), which dispenses 1 brush at a time, thus reducing cross contamination. The new dispenser comes free with four cartridges of 100 Microbrushes. The cartridge is designed to slide onto the dispenser, which is then ready to use.

STATIM—S Sterilizer

Many Orthodontic practices and hospital departments use the Statim Cassette autoclave (Fig. 3), because of the short cycle time (6 minutes for unwrapped instruments). In addition, the design of this autoclave facilitates the use of a tray system (Fig. 4), which is helpful for fixed appliance patients. The STATIM 2000 S has four pre-programs for wrapped, unwrapped, rubber, and plastic instruments.

In the STATIM, steam is produced externally and then injected into the cassette under pressure. Through repeated quick pressure drops, a fractionated flow mechanism is created, pushing the remaining air out of the cassette. The sterilization time is 3.5 minutes at a temperature of 134 degrees C. This, together with the small volume and thin wall of the cassette, which results in short pre-heating and cooling phases, means that the overall cycle time is just 6 minutes.
