

## Editorial

Dear Colleagues,

This Special Issue of the *Journal of Peptide Science* is dedicated to the 1st International Congress on Natural Peptides to Drugs (NP2D) that was held in Zermatt, Switzerland in December 2004. When we initially considered launching this new multidisciplinary event, we were anxious to see the level of support the idea would receive. NP2D started with fresh snow and under the sun and turned out to a true social, scientific and business success (you may visit the congress web-site for more information). We are grateful to the authors for their contributions, the referees for their efforts, pertinence and time. As you will see, the ten articles of this special issue cover a wide variety of fields and nicely represent the natural peptides to drugs field. We hope that you will enjoy reading them.

Finally, we would like to express our deepest gratitude to the scientific steering committee, to our sponsors and exhibitors, to the speakers, to all the participants for their confidence and for the nice atmosphere they created.
