ALCOHOL BONDING.

It is reported that a new T. D., relating to alcohol bonds, was proposed including the so-called "25 percent forfeiture" clause, and it is said that this ruling was prepared in the Prohibition Unit, but because of protests from the drug trade it has been held up.

EXTENSION GRANTED IN CHEMICAL FOUNDATION SUIT.

A thirty-day extension has been allowed the Chemical Foundation in the time for filing its answer to the government's suit in equity for the return of patent holdings to the Alien Property Custodian.

The Foundation asked the extension on the ground that because of the voluminous record in the government's bill more time was needed to go over it and prepare the answer.

SIXTY-SEVENTH CONGRESS ENACTED
295 PUBLIC LAWS.

The second session of the Sixty-seventh Congress convened December 5, 1921, and adjourned after 245 calendar days, exclusive of Sundays and holidays. Two hundred and ninety-five public laws were enacted. The number of bills introduced in the House was 3498; in the Senate, 1249.
