This index is one of three recently published; the other two indexing the areas of chemistry and engineering. It is available monthly as a bound copy and weekly on magnetic tape to institutions with computer operated information systems. The index represents an attempt to bring to scientists information presented at professional conferences without waiting one to two years for the proceedings to be published. ■
