**Eight International Symposium on Pharmaceutical  
and Biomedical Analysis (PBA'97)  
Orlando (Florida)  
4–8 May 1997**

The 8th PBA (Co-chairman: Dr. Henk Lingeman, Amsterdam, The Netherlands and Dr. John F. Stobaugh, Lawrence, KS, USA) belongs to a series of distinguished international symposia, annually held in Europe or the USA. Like the previous symposia Boston (USA, 1991), Baltimore (USA, 1993), Stockholm (Sweden, 1994), St. Louis (USA, 1995) and Osaka (Japan, 1996), it will cover the fundamental aspects, instrumental developments and applications in pharmaceutical and biomedical analysis. The conference will be held in the well known Orlando area (e.g. Kennedy Space center, Universal Studios, Church Street Station, Walt Disney World Resort, Sea World) which is easily accessible by air.

The scientific program will comprise oral presentations in single stream sessions, poster presentations, workshops, and equipment- and technique-related discussion sessions dealing with aspects of special interest. An exhibition of instruments and accessories will ensure strong interaction between instrumentation and scientific communication.

The objective of this Symposium Series is to provide a forum for high-level scientific exchanges between analytical scientists from every corner of the world. All those involved in the analysis of drugs, related materials and endogenous compounds, in all areas of the pharmaceutical and biomedical sciences, are cordially invited to attend.
