International Symposium on Liquid Scintillation Counting

This Symposium which will be held at the Wentworth Hotel, Sydney, Australia on August 20–22, 1973, will be concerned with all aspects of liquid scintillation counting.

Prof. E. Schram (Brussels, Belgium): Bioluminescence assays.

Dr. Y. Kobayashi (Worcester Foundation, U.S.A.): Recent advances in sample preparation techniques.

Review and research contributions are invited from workers in various fields, including for example, the theory of the scintillation process, data processing, preparation of samples, as well as special techniques such as carbon dating, bioluminescence and radioimmunoassay procedures.

A workshop session will be held at which a panel will discuss questions and problems about liquid scintillation counting put by delegates.
