Sixth International Symposium on Gas Kinetics, University of Southampton, Gt. Britain, July 14 - 17, 1980

Sponsored by the Gas Kinetics Group, Faraday Division of the Chemical Society

The Symposium will include invited lectures, short communications and poster sessions and the main discussion topics will be as follows.

A. Theory of Elementary Chemical Processes: introduced by Dr. M. Quack (University of Göttingen).

B. Complex Reactions (including thermal, photochemical and combustion reactions; atmospheric chemistry): introduced by Professor J. G. Calvert (Ohio State University) and by Dr. W. Braun (National Bureau of Standards).

C. Laser Chemistry: introduced by Dr. J. R. McDonald (Naval Research Laboratory).

D. Reactions of Atoms and Small Molecules: introduced by Dr. C. J. Howard (N.O.A.A.).

The Symposium will also include the Polanyi Memorial Lecture to be given by Professor B. A. Thrush (Cambridge), who has been awarded the Michael Polanyi Medal for 1980.

In order to encourage discussion, extended abstracts of all papers will be preprinted and circulated to participants a few weeks prior to the meeting. Accommodation will be available in the University Halls of Residence.
