Conference Topics

The scientific scope of the conference will include most of the basic photochemical areas of interest: primary photophysical and photochemical processes; molecular energy partitioning and transfer; photochemical smog; stratospheric chemical reactions; laser-induced chemistry; solar energy conversion and storage.

Technical Sessions

The conference will be organized around plenary lectures followed by individual contributions most pertinent to the topic of the lecture. Other contributed papers will be scheduled for short presentations as a preview to the poster session. No parallel session is planned, but it is hoped that ample time can be made available for discussions.

Some of the invited lecturers are M. A. El-Sayed, F. Kaufman, S. R. Leone, G. C. Pimentel, M. S. Wrighton, H. E. Hunziker, Y. T. Lee, C. B. Moore, H. Schiff and R. N. Zare.

The first session will begin on Sunday evening, March 30, and the last session will conclude the meeting on Thursday evening, April 3, since the Easter holiday begins on Friday. There will be two half-day sessions daily, with some afternoons free. The conference dinner is scheduled for Wednesday.

Location and Accommodation

Del Webb's Newporter Inn is a resort hotel located near Newport Bay on the Pacific Coast. The hotel is 45 miles south of Los Angeles International Airport and 3 miles south of Santa Ana/Orange County Airport (which will be called John Wayne Airport in 1980) and the campus of the University of California, Irvine.
