Book Review: Finite-Size Scaling, Vol. 2

Finite-Size Scaling, Vol. 2. John L. Cady, ed., North-Holland Press, Amsterdam, 1988.

This is a valuable collection of reprints on finite-size scaling, with only the briefest introduction to the field. In the absence of any full-fledged text on the subject, this collection provides a good sample of the most important papers published on the subject from 1972 (M. E. Fisher and M. N. Barber) to 1987 (Y. Y. Goldschmidt) and for the time being will have to serve in place of a monograph which would help to put technical developments into some perspective.
