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Aims and Scope

This international English-language journal publishes original research and review articles in structural geology and tectonics. All features and processes of deformation in rocks are considered, at any scale. Specific topics include natural structures such as folds, fractures and fabrics, structural associations in orogenic belts, strike-slip zones and extensional regimes, strain analysis, and theoretical and experimental modelling. Regional structural accounts should be of broad rather than local interest, or of a thematic nature. There is an express Brevia section for short notes, discussion/reply items, book reviews and a diary. The journal publishes occasional thematic or conference special issues.
