
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Editorial Note

Besides classical review papers Sulfur Reports also publishes Book Reviews and Annotated Data Sheets [see Editorial Note Sulfur Rep. 11, 359 (1992)].

We have now found it appropriate to launch another category of papers, the Status Paper. A Status Paper will typically be brief and contain original research work of a type which sets standards for future work in the area in question, for instance methodic or mechanistic breakthroughs, key spectroscopic data, or the synthesis of key compounds likely to interest a broad readership. It is hoped that such important papers will be more conspicuous in a review journal such as *Sulphur Reports* than when published elsewhere.
