Participants from the Scandinavian countries are therefore first of all invited, but participants from other countries are welcome as well. SUMMER SCHOOL ON CALORIMETRY, LYON-VILLEURBANNE, 1973

The 2nd Summer School on Calorimetry will be organized, on behalf of the Association Française de Calorimétrie et d'Analyse Thermique, at the Institut National des Sciences Appliquées, at Lyon-Villeurbanne, France, from September 24 to September 29, 1973.

The course is primarily intended for students preparing a PhD Thesis, for scientists from the industry and, more generally, for all persons engaged in the fields of thermal measurements.

The programme will consist i) of lectures, at the graduate level, on the theory and applications of colorinates. DTA and DSC and ii) of practical sessions during which all participants will
