Dr. Epple was born in 1966. He studied at the Technical University in Braunschweig, where he took his diploma in 1989. He received his doctorate in 1992 "summa cum laude". He was a postdoctorate fellow at the University of Washington in 1993. Since 1994 he has been working on his habilitation thesis under the guidance of Prof. Reller at the University of Hamburg. The results of his scientific work have already been presented in 21 publications and 24 lectures at national and international conferences and seminars.

His studies have focussed on solid-state reactions of the most varied organic and inorganic species and he has extensively employed thermal analysis including high-temperature X-ray diffraction. His scientific achievements have been recognized repeatedly in the past.

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
