The 2005 Mediterranean Conference on Calorimetry and Thermal Analysis (MEDICTA2005) is jointly organized by the HSTA and the GECAT, AICAT, GICAT, IGTAC and CATPOR which have been successfully cooperating in the area of calorimetry and thermal analysis. The Conference provides a forum for scientists and engineers throughout the world, interested in the materials thermal properties and the various thermal analysis and calorimetric techniques. In addition to the sessions on various topics of the conference, three workshops have also been scheduled. The workshops will be held with the participation of internationally renowned scientists. The fields to be discussed during these workshops are: Cultural Heritage, Food Science, and Polymers. The latest research findings and applications will be presented, and opportunities for exchanging ideas and opinions on industry-relevant subjects will be given. Due to the increasing interest of other Mediterranean groups to hold the conference in their own countries, in the future a new procedure will be followed according which, the express of interest should be received before the 2005 Conference and the decision will be taken by all members of the different Mediterranean groups present during the Conference e.g. Morocco, Egypt and Turkey.

CALL FOR PAPERS

Conference attendees who wish to participate in the Conference are invited to return the attached registration form. Those who wish to present a paper are asked to submit a one-page abstract in English beginning with the title, the author(s) name(s), affiliation(s) and addresses. The Scientific Committee will review abstracts and decide upon their acceptance and form of presentation (oral or poster). Authors are requested to indicate the type of presentation they prefer. For invited lectures and all oral/poster contributions, a one-page abstract should be sent by e-mail until **January 31st 2005** in A4 format (21 cm x 29.7 cm), 2.5 cm margin on each side, using Times New Roman (title 14pt. bold, text 12pt.) characters. Typed single-spaced.

All contributions presented in the conference may be submitted on site for publication to the Journal of Thermal Analysis and Calorimetry (JTAC) and those that will qualify after a peer-refereeing procedure will be published in a Special Issue.
