

THE ANALYTICAL CHEMISTRY OF URANIUM. By HARRY BREARLEY.
New York: Longmans, Green & Co. 1903. 45 pp. Price, 2s. net.

The book deals with the methods of determining uranium, the separation of uranium from the various elements that are commonly associated with it, and the analysis of uranium ores and alloys, the two ores considered being pitchblende and carnotite. While the treatment of the various topics is quite brief, the work nevertheless contains considerable interesting information, and its appearance is quite timely because of the present activity in the examination of uranium ores as to their radioactive properties and the separation from these ores of uranium and other radioactive substances.
