The nature of some of the mistakes leads one to speculate that parts of the book were set in type from a hand-written manuscript and that proof-reading was done casually, if at all. It cannot be said that anyone making a serious study of the subject matter would be misled, but a want of attention to accuracy of detail is exasperating and should not be a characteristic of a monograph which has the sponsorship of the American Chemical Society. The tradition of the high cost of ACS Monographs has been maintained; considering the stated and worthy objectives of the monographs, consideration might be given to less expensive printing methods or to a subsidy of these publications by the Society.
