Shortening and Oil Production in 1929

Bureau of Census Publishes Figures Showing Slight Decrease in Quantity and Increase in Value for Year



ARD substitutes and vegetable cooking oils produced in the United States in 1929 were totaled 1,691,016,640 pounds, with a value of \$192,031,895,

according to the census of manufactures taken by the Census Bureau, Washington. This was a decrease of 3.3 percent in quantity and an increase of less than one-tenth of one percent in value as compared with 1927, the last previous census year, when the output totaled 1,748,475,056 pounds, valued at \$192,029,802. Of the total for 1929, 1,206,163,486 pounds of lard substitutes and vegetable cooking oils, valued at \$135,987,912, were reported by establishments in the industry (those engaged primarily in the manufacture of lard substitutes

and cooking oils) and 484,853,154 pounds. valued at \$56,043,983, were made as secondary products by establishments engaged primarily in other lines of manufacture, principally meat packing.

There were 38 establishments reporting in 1929 against 33 in 1927, employing 2,462 wage earners in 1929, and 2,655 in 1927. Wages paid in 1929 totaled \$2,627,929, against \$2,624,371 in 1927. Materials, containers, fuel and electric power cost \$131,935,892 in 1929 and \$137,-078,600 in 1927.
